## Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Feast of Pentecost, May 28, 2023

Today we come to the end of the Easter Season with the Feast of Pentecost. Jesus has lived and died, risen from the dead, and ascended into heaven. Now His earthly life is finished, and we are to be witnesses to Him and His teachings all over the earth. This is our Baptismal mission as His followers. At Pentecost Jesus sends His Holy Spirit to be with His disciples & apostles, and they are strengthened to continue His work all over the world. We have received the Holy Spirit at Baptism and have been given the extra grace at Confirmation to go forth and witness to our faith just as the disciples did. This is our vocation! Are we up to the task?

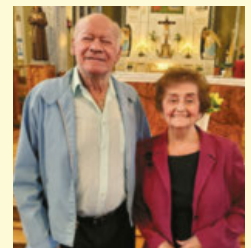


For this Feast of Pentecost, the readings focus obviously on the Holy Spirit. The Acts of the Apostles recounts the coming of the Holy Spirit to the apostles and disciples in the upper room, with a loud noise and tongues of fire. They were filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in foreign tongues. Devout Jews from many nations heard them preaching in their own languages of the mighty works of God. The First Corinthians reading speaks of the impact of the Holy Spirit: the ability to say "Jesus is Lord," and our experiencing different gifts, ministries, and service for the benefit of the Community. It speaks of the



one Body of Christ with its many parts all working together, whether Jew or Greek, slave or free. St. John's Gospel describes Jesus' appearing to the disciples in the locked upper room. He wishes them peace and shows them His wounds. Then He breathes on them, saying, "Receive the Holy Spirit," and commissions them to go forth to preach and forgive sins. Do we appreciate the dramatic effects that the Holy Spirit has in our lives and in the life of the Church, the Body of Christ? Do we bear witness to our Faith?

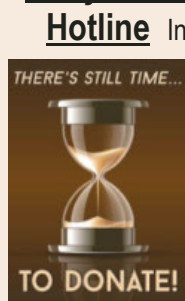

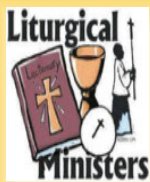
