## Be Someone's Miracle

Our Advent Outreach



Brothers and sisters, Advent begins next weekend! This is a season in which we look forward in hope because of God's power to transform our world. As members of Christ's Body, we are called to be instruments of that transformation in many ways. We reach out to those in pain, in confusion, and in need. We offer words and actions of consolation and encouragement. In that spirit, I invite all of us to participate in **Be Someone's Miracle**, our parish's special Advent outreach project to build safe, sturdy homes in Guatemala.

Jesus was born in what was likely a dirt-floor stable or cave. Sadly, many of our brothers and sisters in Guatemala currently live in conditions that are similarly unwholesome and unsafe. Through this outreach project, we can help these families remain united and strong by giving local Catholic leaders the funds they need to build simple yet durable homes in rural villages.

By participating in this mission of mercy, we will join other parishes throughout the U.S. to help build 224 homes in three Guatemalan dioceses, giving 1,164 people the safety and security to begin building a better life in their own communities. At a cost of just \$8,892 per home, a gift of any size goes a long way toward changing lives.

We are undertaking this effort through a partnership with our friends Cross Catholic Outreach, a trusted U.S.-based Catholic relief and development ministry. Cross Catholic Outreach collaborates with a network of bishops, priests, sisters and lay missionaries to uplift the poorest of the poor in more than 30 countries around the world, including in Guatemala.

As a thank you for our compassion, Cross Catholic Outreach is providing our parish with free resources. This includes a Children's Advent Activity Guide to help young families learn about the season through crafts, activities, and stories. We will share those each week in the bulletin.

You will find inside this bulletin some general information about the project. I also invite you visit the display in the front vestibule in coming to learn more about the project.

May God bless you as we join together to love his people in Christ's holy Name.
