

# Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2022

I hope you all had a wonderful and enjoyable Thanksgiving holiday celebration. The Lord has blessed us in many ways and this was our annual opportunity to give

thanks to God for His generosity and love. Of course we are called to give thanks at every Eucharist for the gift of Jesus' Body and Blood—the word Eucharist itself means "thanks." The weather sort of warmed up for us after a couple weeks of



unseasonably cold and dreary days and nights. It kind of reminded me of my days in Detroit during my college years of 1962 to 1967. As soon as we crossed from Ohio to Michigan after Christmas break, the sky clouded up and we didn't see the sun for several months.

We have now reached the beginning of the new Church Year with the First Sunday of Advent. So our Sunday readings now come from Year A. Our first reading this weekend is from the Prophet Isaiah. Isaiah describes for us the



nations of the world streaming toward the Lord's house on a high mountain. His vision is of the restored Jerusalem that the people will celebrate after their years of exile in Babylon. It will be a time of peace, with swords beaten into plowshares and spears into pruning hooks. He promises no more war! St. Paul's Letter to the Romans is also very positive. He says that salvation is coming closer and the people should throw off the works of darkness and sin.

They and we should put on the Lord Jesus Christ in all our behavior. Our Gospel is from Matthew's Chapter 24, an optimistic description of the coming of the Son of Man, Jesus, at the end of time. So while we are preparing for the birth of our Savior, our Scriptures are still looking to the end time. We are reminded to be ready and prepared for Jesus' return. How are we dealing with the issues of our times?

Thanks to all who donated to the Catholic Campaign for Human Development this past weekend and to all who purchased hand carved olive wood art from Bethlehem from the Blest Art representatives after Masses. Thanks also to our parishioners who have responded to the United Catholic Appeal and have sent in their

pledges and checks. There is still time to respond and help us meet our \$32,000 goal.

We want to express our sympathy to the family of Martha Theresa Harnishfeger whose memorial Mass and burial were celebrated at St. Mary's of the Rock on this past Tuesday. May she rest in peace and may her family be consoled.
