
Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 30, 2022

Diane Wendell. We appreciate the willingness of all 8 to serve the needs of Holy Family Parish, and promise to keep all of them in our prayers. Thanks also to all who participated in this annual Parish Council election by voting at Mass last weekend.

Our first reading from the Book of Wisdom speaks of God's great love for all of His



creation, and God's desire to forgive any and all sinners who are willing to repent. St. Paul writes to the Thessalonians encouraging them to live worthy lives so that the name of the Lord may be glorified. He also tells them not to worry about the supposed immediate coming of the Lord. St. Luke recounts when Jesus invited the chief tax collector Zacchaeus to come down from the sycamore tree so that Jesus could visit with him. Zacchaeus

was so moved that he promised to pay back anyone he had defrauded. Jesus praises him and says that "today salvation has come to this house."
