Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

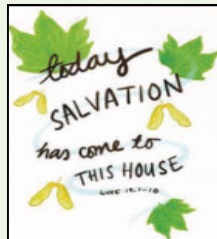
Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 30, 2022

We appreciate the willingness of all 8 to serve the needs of Holy Family Parish, and promise to keep all of them in our prayers. Thanks also to all who participated in this annual Parish Council election by voting at Mass last weekend.



Our first reading from the Book of Wisdom speaks of God's great love for all of His

creation, and God's desire to forgive any and all sinners who are willing to repent. St. Paul writes to the Thessalonians encouraging them to live worthy lives so that the name of the Lord may be glorified. He also tells them not to worry about the supposed immediate coming of the Lord. St. Luke recounts when Jesus invited the chief tax collector Zacchaeus to come down from the sycamore tree so that Jesus could visit with him. Zacchaeus



was so moved that he promised to pay back anyone he had defrauded. Jesus praises him and says that "today salvation has come to this house."

Last week I met with our Music Ministers and we discussed what we can do to increase the singing and participation at our weekend Masses. I would like to encourage all our parishioners to answer the prayers more loudly and sing more forcefully, even if you are not confident about your singing ability. The Vatican Council II challenged us to have full, active, and conscious participation at all our celebrations of God's gracious mercy as we feed on the Scriptures and receive the gift of Christ's Body and Blood. We have music books in each pew to help us sing and give us the texts for the readings and responses. Let us use our voices to praise God! The one who sings once, prays twice!

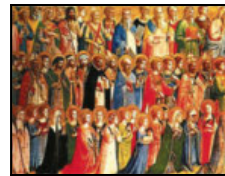
A Prayer for Life

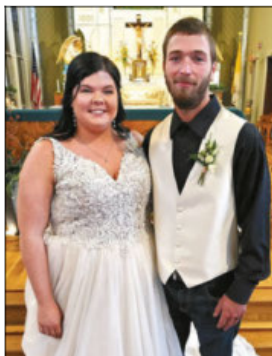
