Today, on Palm Sunday (also called Passion Sunday), the Church enters the holiest week of the Christian year. It is the week devoted to the center of our faith: the passion, death and resurrection of the Lord, which we call the Paschal (which means "Easter") Mystery. This is the

Mystery of God's infinite goodness and boundless mercy toward us. It is the Mystery of Christ's victory over sin and death. It is the Mystery of our redemption.

Please join us later this week as we celebrate this divine goodness and mercy. On **Holy Thursday at 7pm** we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper, in which Jesus made a gift to us of His Body and Blood. At **2pm on Good Friday** we will remember and give thanks for the salvation Christ won for us on the cross. At the **Easter Vigil, which starts at 9pm** on Holy Saturday, we will rejoice at Christ's resurrection and His victory over sin and death. **Easter Day Masses will be at 8am, 10am, and 11am (at St. Mary of the Rock).**

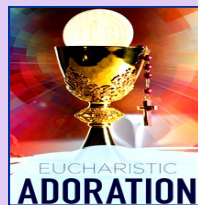
