Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord, March 24, 2024

This weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord. We will bless and distribute palms at the beginning of all the Masses. We will also read the Passion of the Lord according to St. Mark in 3 parts for our Gospel. We invite all to join in the responses as given in your Missalettes. Holy Week begins this weekend.



We begin our liturgy with the joyful account of Jesus entering Jerusalem to the "Hosannas!" of the people, followed by the blessing of the palms. Then the tone changes dramatically and we hear from Isaiah's Suffering Servant song, describing the experience of the suffering servant. St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians tells us of Jesus emptying Himself of His divinity and taking on the form of a slave as He becomes human in Mary's womb and eventually dies on the cross.

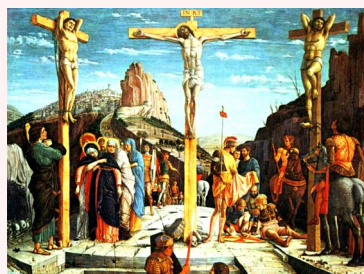


God exalts Him and calls all to honor Him by bending the knee and confessing that Jesus is Lord to the glory of God.

Then we read the Passion account according to St. Mark, and are reminded of all that Jesus underwent on our behalf, beginning with His being anointed with costly spikenard oil by a woman. Jesus celebrates the Passover feast in Jerusalem with His apostles. During the Passover dinner Jesus reveals that He will be betrayed, and institutes the Eucharist by blessing the bread and wine, declaring them to be His Body and Blood, and sharing them with His disciples. They go to the Garden of Gethsemane and Jesus prays while the disciples sleep. He is arrested



by the crowd led by Judas' kiss and the crowd takes Jesus to the High Priest and elders. They testify against Him and call for His death because of "blasphemy." He is led to Pilate for more questioning and is handed back for crucifixion. Pilate releases Barabbas instead of Jesus. The soldiers mock and beat Jesus and He carries His cross to Golgotha with Simon of Cyrene's help. Jesus is crucified and His garments are divided. As He is dying on the cross, He is mocked and called "The King of the



Jews." Two thieves are also crucified with Him. The curtain in the Temple is torn in two and the centurion says, "Truly this man was the Son of God." The dead Jesus is taken down and placed in the tomb of Joseph of Arimathea. How do you respond to Jesus' death on the cross for you? What changes are you making in your life this Easter?

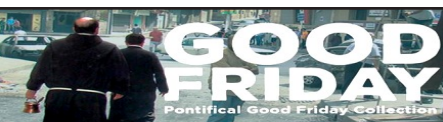

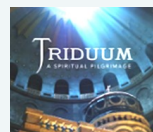
