"There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit" (1 Corinthians 12:4).

What is Saint Paul talking about when he refers to the "spiritual gifts"? These are gifts from the Holy Spirit given to each of us in the course of our Christian life. They are God's grace at work in our lives. We don't all receive the same gifts, but we all receive some.

Spiritual gifts are special abilities, talents, or capacities given to us for serving God and others. They are meant to build up the body of Christ, the Church (Ephesians

4:12). Saint Paul mentions them in a few places. In his letter to the Romans, he talks about the gifts of prophecy (speaking about and preaching the gospel), serving others selflessly to meet their needs, teaching, encouragement, leadership, and kindness to those in distress (12:6-8). In another place (1 Corinthians 12:8-10), he includes wisdom (the ability to understand and apply God's truth in everyday life), healing, discernment of spirits (determining whether inspirations come from God or from something or someone else). And he also refers to special roles in the Church, such as apostles, evangelists, and pastors (Ephesians 4:11). Of course, Paul reminds us that of all the gifts we have received from God, the greatest of these is love (1 Corinthians 13:13). Without love, none of the other gifts fulfill their purpose.

Each one of us has been given gifts from the Holy Spirit to help us follow Jesus faithfully and enthusiastically, to invite others to do the same, to help people, or to serve in formal or informal Church ministry. Some are great teachers, others are particularly good at listening, and others know how to mobilize and motivate people to get good things done. What gifts do you think the Spirit has given you? Celebrate Pentecost by asking the Holy Spirit to help you know your gifts and to use them for the glory of God and good of the Church.

Safe Haven baby boxes allow the anonymous and safe surrender of infants by parents who cannot care for them. In Indiana a parent or designated individual can surrender a baby up to 30 days old to a designated safe haven location without fear of prosecution. Safe Haven baby boxes have a heating and cooling element to keep the baby comfortable and a silent alarm to notify first responders to immediately care for the baby. The babies are then adopted out to families. Locally there are Safe Haven baby boxes at Margaret Mary Hospital in Batesville and the fire stations in Sunman, Milan, and Versailles. Parents in need can also call the 24/7 Safe Haven Crisis Hotline at 1-888-510-BABY.





FORMED PICK OF THE WEEK Saint Peter tells the epic story about the key event in European and world history: the spread of Christianity throughout the Roman Empire, focusing on the leader of that new religion. The film illustrates the strong reaction of Romans and Jews from a political and religious standpoint, and it also deals with the immense obstacles Christianity encountered in the early stages of its development. As a dedicated follower of Christ, Peter spreads the message of the Gospel across the land, often staying only one step ahead of those determined to persecute him. As the tension between Christians and Romans grows, blood runs in the streets. Peter and Paul meet and together they form a strong friendship in preaching about Christ. While fleeing persecution in the Eternal City, Peter sees Jesus walking toward him saying, "Peter, I am coming to Rome, to be crucified again." Peter realizes he must follow Christ to the end, and returns to Rome to be crucified like his master.
