## Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Feast of Pentecost - May 19, 2024

I hope all of our mothers and their families had a great celebration of Mother's Day last Sunday. The weather certainly cooperated and made for a perfect celebration. The fact that it occurred on the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord made it extra special because our mothers are usually the ones who teach us as children to love as Jesus did.

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost. It marks the end of the Easter Season. Next weekend we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity and then Corpus Christi with its special procession. Our Scriptures today for Pentecost emphasize the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. The reading from



Acts describes the noise like a driving wind (tornado?) filling the house. Tongues of fire rested on each person. They spoke different languages and were able to be understood by all the citizens from the other nations visiting Jerusalem. The mighty acts of God were celebrated by all! In our second reading St. Paul speaks to the people regarding the various kinds of spiritual gifts given by the Holy Spirit to the community. These gifts

are given for some important purpose. As each human body has many parts that work together, so the body of Christ has received many gifts, talents, and abilities from the Spirit for the benefit of all. And as such, we are all called to work together using these gifts!

Our Gospel passage from St. John describes that the disciples were in a locked room because of their fear. But Jesus came to them and said, "Peace be with you!" Then Jesus showed them his wounded hands and side and the disciples rejoiced that Jesus was with them again. Jesus repeated his wish of Peace and then breathed on them and sent them out with the gifts of the Holy Spirit to do His work of forgiving sins. We, too, have received the gifts of the Holy Spirit in Baptism and Confirmation. **Do you realize that you, too, are** 

being sent out to do the work of Jesus? How do you proclaim the Good News by your words and deeds? Remember, St. Francis said, "Preach always, if necessary, use words!" We are Jesus' hands and feet and


