#### Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Second Sunday of Advent, December 10, 2023

Thanks to all who were involved in the Holidays Under the Spires in any way. All seemed to go well from my perspective, and I was exhausted by the end of the day. I started out with the Knights' Breakfast with Santa, then had 3 Baptisms at St. Mary's of the Rock. I came home to the Combined Choirs' concert in the Sisters' Chapel, and the fabulous luncheon prepared and provided by our own Matt Trossman. I'm told the Craft Fair





went very well in our school, which I missed. The St. Francis's First Crèche skit, put on by our Secular Franciscans, was well attended, along with my blessing of our new crèche figures. I also enjoyed the Kolping Singers German carols in the Sisters' Chapel. These and many other street scenes can be viewed on my Facebook page.

Our Scriptures for the Second Sunday of Advent really get to the heart of the Advent season. The beautiful Isaiah reading is very upbeat and consoling. Israel has fully paid for its sins and this is a time of new beginnings for the people. The desert is being prepared for God to bring His people back home; now is a time of victory and peace. The people are to cry out the good news of God's victory as the good shepherd. St. Peter reminds the people that the Lord is coming again, even though it seems like a delay. They



are told to be conducting themselves in holiness and devotion, waiting for the new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. The Lord is coming!

The beginning of St. Mark's Gospel tells us that God is sending His messenger to prepare His way. John the Baptist is preaching in the wilderness, proclaiming a



baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. People from all over Judea are going out to John for his rite of baptism in the Jordan River. John says he is not worthy to be the Messiah, but is preparing for the One who will Baptize with the Holy Spirit. How are we preparing for the coming of Jesus our Messiah, born on Christmas? Are we taking time to

reflect on the great gift that Jesus is to us and our world at this time of war and conflict hostility between nations and religions and families, even ours? We have 2 weeks to get our hearts and houses in order for the coming of the Messiah!


