Prepare the way of the Lord... (Luke 3:4)

Advent is the beginning of the Church's liturgical year. New year, new you! In celebration of the coming of Jesus to save us and free us from everything that holds us down, let's raise a prayer: Holy Spirit, show me the ways that I resist you, the ways I oppose Your desire to reshape me into the person I was created to be.

Besides praying for the gift of conversion, how else can we prepare the way of the Lord this Advent? Consider spending the next year learning about the Bible (find Fr. Mike Schmitz's podcast, *The Bible in a Year*), or about the faith (he also has a podcast called *The Catechism in a Year*). Embark on a year of dedicated spiritual reading. There are so many things out there; find a favorite author or saint and fill your soul with good things (for example, read Dorothy Day if you are drawn to social action; read Thomas Dubay if you are drawn to prayer). Watch *good* videos on YouTube about the faith: Bishop Robert Barron, Fr. Columba Jordan ["Called to More"], Ascension Press, and many more. Check out the website *Formed* for a lot of great videos and audio books about our faith (see inside the bulletin for more information about *Formed*).

Spend less time obsessing about the news and more time praying the Rosary or with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament (or both!). Volunteer at the Batesville Food Pantry or some other good cause. Get yourself to confession. Go to Mass one more day a week if you can manage it.

Whatever you do, make a commitment to do something this year to rev up your spiritual life. *Prepare the way of the Lord!* 

And may Jesus, in Whom we place all our hope, give you always and everywhere His peace.


