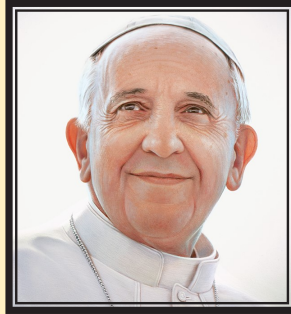

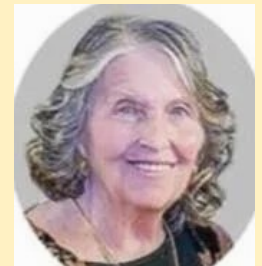

The Batesville Food Pantry has served our community for decades and continues to be an integral and valuable resource to our community, oftentimes assisting beyond food to our neighbors in need. Last year, as food prices saw unprecedented increases, the Food Pantry served an average of nearly 800 local residents each month. One of these clients was a young man, just 22 years old caring for a handicapped brother and girlfriend while working a full-time job. This little family lived in a tent and bathed in a creek, but due to the Food Pantry's provisions, they were able to have personal care items and fresh and canned food to sustain them month-over-month.

The Batesville Area Ministerial Association (BAMA) continues to oversee the Food Pantry and meet our **MISSION** to fulfill the call of Jesus Christ to love our neighbors by providing convenient and healthy food options at no cost for food-insecure neighbors. We are blessed to have the support of numerous churches, volunteers, community members and businesses. However, we have reached a point where donations no longer cover our annual need creating a ~\$1500 deficit each month. This is concerning and certainly not sustainable long term.

We ask that you prayerfully consider how you might help us to continue to meet our vision. Your support is invaluable, and no gift is too small.

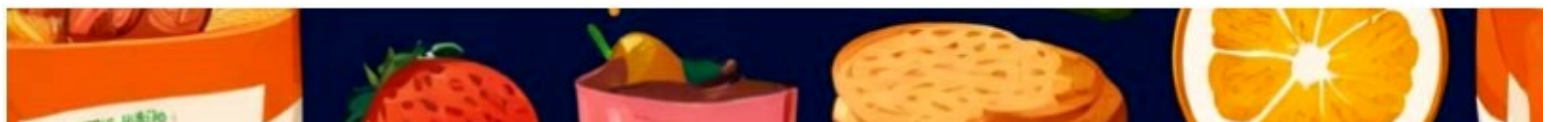
