Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections Second Sunday of Lent, February 25, 2024

I hope everyone is happy who was looking for some winter snow! Our 4 inches was just enough to give us a beautiful view and a few slick spots on the roads, and a

4 hour power outage. Our RCIA candidates and catechumens gathered last Sunday at the Cathedral in Indianapolis for the Rite of Election. This Rite confirms their desire to become Catholics and be fully initiated into Please keep them in your the Church.



prayers as they complete their Lenten period of preparation to join us at Easter.

Our Scriptures for this Second Week of Lent emphasize our faith and trust in our loving God. In the Genesis reading, Abraham is tested by God when he is told to take



his son Isaac up on the mountain and offer him as a sacrifice to God. Abraham was ready to slay Isaac when God cried out and told him not to hurt the boy. Abraham passed the test showing his complete commitment and obedience to God, and sacrificed a ram instead. God responded by promising Abraham countless descendants because of his obedience. In the second reading, St. Paul reminds the Romans that God is on their side: God did not spare his own Son, but handed Jesus over for our

salvation. The risen Jesus is at God's right hand, interceding for us and our needs. We are called to put all our trust in Him.

Our Gospel today from St. Mark recounts Jesus' Transfiguration on a high mountain. Jesus had Peter, James, and John with Him when His clothes became dazzling white and Moses and Elijah, symbolizing the Old Testament Torah and the Prophets, appeared there with them. When Peter suggested making 3 tents for

Moses, Elijah, and Jesus, God spoke to them saying, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him." The disciples were overwhelmed by this experience, and Jesus told them to not tell anyone until He rose from the dead. They obeyed, but wondered what "rising from the dead" meant. This preview of Jesus' glory was to give them the strength they needed to remain faithful to Jesus, even in His suffering and dying on the cross before His rising from the dead. How do we respond to Jesus'

Transfiguration? Does it give us new insights into Jesus' divinity as well as His obedience to the Father? During this Season of Lent are we growing in our commitment to following Jesus and being obedient to God, as we bring the good news to others? Are we listening to Jesus as God commanded?

Thanks to some generous donors, our school cafeteria and kitchen floors have been resurfaced with a new decorative and easy to maintain permanent finish!

We welcome Fr. Joe back to Holy Family from his rehab program in Michigan.


