# Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections


Feast of the Holy Family, December 31, 2023

This Sunday's feast is the Patronal Feast of our Holy Family Parish, so we can especially enjoy this special celebration this year, which fell on Friday, December 30, last year, Mon, January 1, 2024, is the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. So we have 2 very special



feasts 2 days in a row. Since this Feast of the Holy Family which is also the Octave Day of the Nativity falls on Monday, it is not a Holyday of Obligation this year. We will still have a Vigil Mass on Sunday evening at 7 PM (New Year's Eve) and one Feastday Mass at 8 AM on Monday morning, January 1, 2024.

The Scriptures for this Feast of the Holy Family speak to us about the importance of family life and the responsibilities of children and parents. Our first reading from the Book of Sirach celebrates loving fathers and mothers and the blessings their children receive. It also reminds us of the responsibilities of children toward their parents as they age, and the benefits the parents will receive from good care. In our second reading St. Paul writes to the Colossians, sharing the many good attitudes and practices that promote genuine family life and bring



peace and joy to the family. Everything is to be done in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him. Wives and husbands are to love, support, and care for each other, and model this love for their children. Thus harmony

will thrive in the home.



St. Luke's Gospel describes the ceremony of Presentation and Purification for new parents. Joseph and Mary carried out this ritual in the Jerusalem temple. Simeon, a righteous and devout man, praised God for allowing him to see and bless baby Jesus when He was presented in the temple. Simeon also

prophesized that Jesus would be a sign for the Israelites, and that Mary's heart would be broken during her life. The prophetess Anna also gave thanks to God for the child, and spoke about Him to all who were awaiting the Messiah. The Holy Family returned

to Nazareth, and the Child grew in wisdom, age, and grace. Are our families marked by these same attitudes and actions as we grow together, imitating the love and care that marked the Holy Family? How is God calling our families today to practice these virtues and attitudes and care?



We offer our sympathy and prayers to the family of Rita Struewing whose funeral was celebrated on December 19, 2023. May she rest in peace and may her loved ones be consoled!


