Put on love, that is, the bond of perfection (Colossians 3:14)

This Sunday the Church celebrates the Holy Family, and of course here we celebrate it in a special way. Many parishes have a single patron saint, but we have two of the greatest saints and the Lord Himself looking over us! We are very blessed, and it shows. Our parish family is strong in worship and in service and getting stronger all the time.

Saint John reminds us that we are God's children (1 John 3:2). We belong to the family of God, a very Holy Family indeed. The one thing that should mark such a family is love, what Saint Paul calls "the bond of perfection." This is the kind of love that God shows us by creating us, redeeming us from our sins and failings, and offering to share His life with us in His Kingdom. Saint Paul reminds us that such love is shown through "heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another..." (Colossians 3:12-13).

Not everyone has the experience of coming from a loving family. Some families are severely broken, while others never really came together in the first place. But as members of God's family, we should all be able to feel that we are loved by our Christian brothers and sisters, and we should be prepared to show them the love they deserve. On this feast of the Holy Family let's pray for all our families, that they may know and show love:

We bless Your name, O Lord, for sending Your own incarnate Son to become part of a family, so that, as He lived its life, He would experience its worries and its joys. We ask You, Lord, to protect and watch over our families, so that in the strength of Your grace their members may enjoy prosperity, possess the priceless gift of your peace, and, as the Church alive in the home, bear witness in this world to Your glory. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.

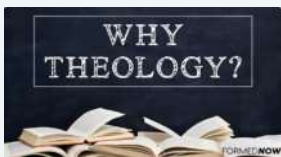
