

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Feast of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, June 2, 2024

Last Monday, May 27, was Memorial Day, a special day of remembrance of our men and women in the military who gave up their lives in service of our country. We had our traditional cemetery service honoring our fallen soldiers. I hope you all had safe and memorable celebrations, too. It is also the unofficial beginning of Summer.





This weekend we celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi, with our annual Corpus Christi Procession after the 10 AM Mass. It goes through our cemetery and woods to the shrines located there, plus several other temporary altars where we also have Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. This is followed

by a special luncheon in our cafeteria for all participants.


The first reading from Exodus tells of the celebration that Moses prescribed for the Israelites to perform. It focuses on the sacrifices of young bulls on the altar

Moses prepared at the foot of the mountain. After he read from the book of the Covenant, Moses splashed some of the blood of the bulls on the people, ratifying their commitment to follow their Covenant with God. Our second reading from the Book of Hebrews describes the new Covenant of Jesus upon the Cross. Jesus pours out his blood for us to obtain our eternal



redemption, far beyond what any animal sacrifice can achieve with its blood. Jesus is the mediator of this new Covenant for us.

Our Gospel from St. Mark describes Jesus' Passover Supper in the upper room. Jesus sent two of his disciples to prepare the Passover supper. During the supper Jesus took bread and blessed it and said, "Take it, this is my body." Then he took a cup of wine, gave thanks, and gave it to the disciples, saying, "This is my



blood of the covenant which will be shed for many," and they all drank of the cup. Then they all went out to the Mount of Olives where Jesus was betrayed by Judas. How do you understand this action of Jesus at the Last Supper? Do you truly believe that the bread and wine become the Body and Blood, soul and divinity, of Jesus at Mass? This belief is the central doctrine and substance of our Catholic faith. It is

truly a miracle that we participate in every time we receive the Eucharist at Mass. How are you changed by this miracle?




