180 Years of Corpus Christi Processions

This year we will be celebrating 180 continuous years of Corpus Christi processions here in Oldenburg. Corpus Christi processions are a traditional feature of the feast of Corpus Christi, which was officially instituted by Pope Urban IV in 1264. The institution of Corpus Christi coincided with increased devotion to the Eucharist, spurred by reported Eucharistic miracles and by debates with heretical groups who denied that the bread and wine become the Body and Blood at Mass. The establishment of Corpus Christi marked a significant moment in Catholic liturgical history, emphasizing the centrality of the Eucharist.

Corpus Christi processions serve as a public profession of our belief that the Eucharist is not merely a symbol but the actual Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ. Processions bring the Eucharist into the streets as an act of worship and evangelization. The act of processing with the Blessed Sacrament emphasizes Christ's abiding presence among His people, fulfilling His promise to remain with the Church always (Matthew 28:20). Corpus Christi processions also are celebrations and proclamations of salvation. The public nature of the processions reflects the Church's mission to share the Gospel with the world. By carrying the Eucharist through communities, Catholics express their faith in Christ's presence and invite others to encounter Him.

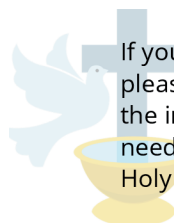
