# Holy Family Parish



*"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."*

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. It's the feast of who God is. Every Sunday – every Mass, really – is dedicated to the Trinity, but since the 1300s, the Church has celebrated this feast on the Sunday after Pentecost to help us focus more explicitly on who God is. This is important for many

reasons, including the fact that we are made in God's image and likeness. Which means when we contemplate who God is, we also contemplate who we are and how we are to be in the world. The Christian life is meant to be a Trinitarian life.

This fact is reflected in the way we worship God. Every time we celebrate Mass, we are immersed in the life of the Trinity. Everything we do and say during Mass is nothing other than a dialogue between us and the Father, through the person of Jesus Christ, in the light and with the help of the Holy Spirit. We begin Mass in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. In the middle of the Mass we proclaim our belief "in one God, the Father Almighty...in one Lord, Jesus Christ...in the Holy Spirit." At the end of the Eucharistic Prayer, the priest lifts up the Body and Blood of Christ to the Father and we offer ourselves along with Him: "Through Him, with Him, and in Him, O God, Almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is Yours, forever and ever." At the end of the Mass we receive a blessing in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

All the other Sacraments also feature the Trinity, as do many of our Catholic prayers, especially the Sign of the Cross and the Glory Be. So our Catholic lives are immersed in the Trinity from beginning (Baptism) to end (last rites and funeral) and every day in every way in between.
