

Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections The Most Holy Trinity, June 4, 2023

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, and next weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Our Scriptures today each reveal something about our God who is Three in

One. The Exodus reading tells of Moses' meeting the Lord on Mt. Sinai to receive the 10 Commandments. Moses bows down before the Lord and prays for God to pardon the peoples' sinfulness and to come along with them on their travels. In the second reading St. Paul prays for the Corinthians to live in peace, and proclaims, "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you." St. John's Gospel gives us the famous, "God so loved



the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life." God did not send Jesus to condemn our world but that He might save it! We are called to believe in the name of the only Son of God and thus be saved. May this feast of the Holy Trinity remind us that our loving God is Three Persons in One God, truly a mystery and a blessing for us.




