Fr. Carl's Thoughts and Reflections

Feast of the Most Holy Trinity - May 26, 2024

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, the fact that God is Three Divine Persons. Last week we celebrated the Feast of Pentecost, the end of the Easter Season and the Birthday of the Church. Next week we will celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, with our annual Corpus Christi procession through the cemetery, woods & campus of the Sisters & Oldenburg Academy. Then, we return back through town to Holy Family Church, with Benedictions at each of the shrines.


Last Sunday at the 10 AM Mass we also celebrated the Final Profession of




4 of our Secular Franciscans, Helen Lewis, Suzanne Dickman, Dave Rieman and Teri Rieman. Many other Secular Franciscans joined us to lead the celebration and receive their promises. Afterwards, the Secular Franciscans sponsored donuts, fruit, juices, and coffee for all who gathered in the cafeteria after the Mass.

This weekend is the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, and our Scriptures give us a

picture of the activity of the Holy Trinity. Our first reading from Deuteronomy recounts the great works of God the Father in creating the world, choosing the Israelites to be His people, & leading them out of slavery in Egypt. He gave Moses the Ten Commandments so that the people might prosper in the land God gave them forever. The second reading from St. Paul's Letter to the Romans reminds them that they are sons and daughters of God and are led by the Holy Spirit. They are no longer slaves but have received the Spirit of adoption and can cry, "Abba, Father!" We are also heirs of God with Christ, if we suffer with Him so we may be glorified with Him.



Our Gospel from St. Matthew tells of Jesus' appearance to the Eleven disciples on the mountain in Galilee just before His Ascension. Jesus approaches them and tells them to make disciples of all nations by baptizing them "in the name of the Father,



and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Jesus adds that they must teach the newly Baptized to practice all that He showed them. Jesus promises to be with them (and us) until the end of the world. How do you understand and appreciate the mystery of the Holy Trinity? Do you pray to each person of the Trinity according to their special gifts as Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier? Which is your favorite?




