Today's Gospel, on the feast of the Most Holy Trinity, demonstrates the mystery of God's love for the world, His creation. In the brief dialogue with Nicodemus, Jesus presents Himself as the One who brings to fulfilment the Father's plan of salvation for the world. He famously states: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son" (John 3:16).

These words affirm that the action of the three divine Persons — Father, Son and Holy Spirit — is all a single plan of love that saves humanity and the world; it is a plan of salvation for us. The world God created was good and beautiful, but after sin, the world is marked by evil and corruption. We men and women are sinners,

all of us. God could respond by intervening to judge the world, to destroy evil and to castigate sinners. Instead, He loves the world, despite its sins; God loves each one of us even when we make mistakes and distance ourselves from Him. God the Father loves the world so much that, in order to save it, He gives what is most precious to Him: His only-begotten Son, Who gives His life for humanity, rises again, returns to the Father and together with Him sends the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is therefore Love (1 John 4:8), wholly at the service of the world, which He wishes to save and re-create. And today, thinking of God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, we think of God's love! And it would be beautiful if we felt that we were loved: "God loves me!" This is today's sentiment.

Let us think of how God reveals himself to Moses: full of tenderness, merciful, gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness (Exodus 34:6). The encounter with this God encouraged Moses, who, as the Book of Exodus tells us, was not afraid to stand between the people and the Lord, saying to Him: although it is a stiff-necked people, pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for your inheritance (Exodus 34:9). And this is what God did, by sending His Son. We are children in the Son with the strength of the Holy Spirit! We are God's legacy!

Dear brothers and sisters, today's feast day invites us to let ourselves once again be fascinated by the beauty of God: beauty, goodness, and inexhaustible truth... which became flesh in order to enter our life, our history, my history, the history of each one of us, so that every man and woman may encounter it and have eternal life. And this is faith: to welcome welcome this God-Love who gives Himself in Christ, who moves us in the Holy Spirit; to let ourselves be encountered by Him and to trust in Him. This is Christian life. To love, to encounter God, to seek God, Who seeks us first; He encounters us first.

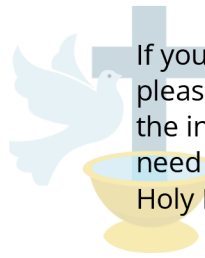
