## Holy Family Parish



This week we celebrate Gaudete (gow-DAY-tay) Sunday, the Sunday in Advent that invites us to rejoice (that's what *Gaudete* means), even now in the midst of whatever trials or

uncertainties we carry. The Church clothes herself in rose today, a splash of joy amid the violet of our waiting, reminding us that the Lord is near.

Today we hear the prophet Isaiah speaking to a people crushed by exile, their land barren and their spirits broken. Yet, he proclaims that in God's mercy the wilderness will rejoice and blossom like a garden. Weak hands will be strengthened, fearful hearts reassured: "Be strong, do not fear! Here is your God." And then the miracles: blind eyes opened, deaf ears unstopped, the lame leaping like deer, waters bursting forth in the desert. It's a vision of redemption, where sorrow flees and everlasting joy crowns the redeemed as they return to Zion singing. Isaiah's prophecy echoes the cries of Advent: God is coming to save, to heal, to restore what sin has withered.

John the Baptist, now languishing in Herod's prison, sends his disciples to Jesus to ask: "Are you the one who is to come, or are we to wait for another?" Jesus points to His works: "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them. And blessed is anyone who takes no offense at me." Jesus has been fulfilling Isaiah's prophecy – the desert is blooming in healings and preachings.

John's question from prison might mirror our own Advent longings: in a world of injustice, violence, and personal struggles, is God really coming? Is Jesus truly the One? The answer is Yes, and you can recognize Him in the signs. In our own prisons or deserts – strained relationships, health scares, financial worries, habitual sins we just cannot seem to overcome – we can see signs of God's grace at work: a kind word that opens blind eyes to possibility, a helping hand that lifts the bowed down, good news shared in a conversation that frees the imprisoned heart, forgiveness extended in the Sacrament of Penance.

As we draw nearer to Christmas, let's look for signs in our daily lives that God is indeed bringing healing, wholeness, and holiness into our lives. Just as in the gray of winter our little town is lit up with Christmas lights that cheer the heart, so in the difficulties of our lives, God's love and saving power can brighten the gloom and give us the courage and hope to go on. As we light the rose candle of Gaudete Sunday, may God fill us with the joy of His Son's nearness, strengthening our feeble knees, opening our eyes to His signs, and granting us patience. May we bloom like the desert crocus and sing God's praises forever.
