

Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! (Philippians 4:4)

Anyone who has been up early enough to catch the sunrise this time of year can appreciate the color of the vestments the priest wears this Sunday. As the sun peeks over the horizon the sky is cast with a blend of purple and rose, a joyful herald of a new day. Just so, the priest is decked out in rose vestments with purple ac-

cents to signal the approach of Christmas, when the "dawn from on high" – Jesus Christ – will shine upon the earth. We call today Gaudete Sunday. "Gaudete" means "rejoice," and in our second reading Saint Paul encourages the Philippians to "rejoice always." Why? Because "the Lord is near."

The prophet Zephaniah, in the first reading, also encourages God's people to "shout for joy" because God is in their midst as savior. In fact, the prophet tells us that **God Himself** *will rejoice over His people and sing joyfully because of them.* Not only do the goodness and mercy of God bring us joy, but our salvation brings God joy. No wonder Jesus often talks about the Kingdom of God as a banquet – a party!

As we continue our Advent journey toward the celebration of the Nativity of Jesus, it's important for us to remember that "God so loved the world that He sent His only Son," that God *wants* every one of us to be saved and to enjoy all the gifts He offers us, in this life and in the next. We are not a burden to God, and our sinfulness and brokenness, no matter how bad they may be, do not stop God from loving us; we remain His children. So, yes, *Gaudete!* Rejoice in the Lord always, because He rejoices in us.


